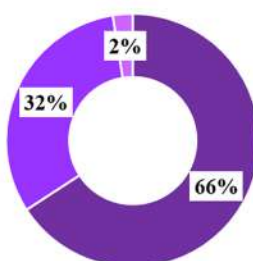

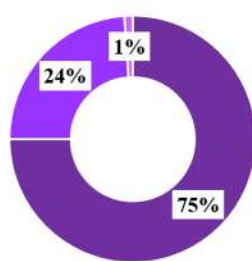
I.C.S.E Results - 2025

■ 90 & Above ■ 80 - 89 ■ 70 - 79



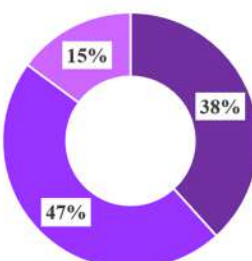
I.S.C. Results - 2025
